## **COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION**

### **1.1. Information You Provide:**

We may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you visit our website, subscribe to our newsletter, or engage in information request activities. This information may include your name, email address, phone number, and any other information that you provide to us.

### **1.2. Information Automatically Collected:**

### **2.2. Legal and Compliance:**

We may also use your personal information to protect our rights, safety, and property, as well as those of our investors and stakeholders.

### **2.3. Analytics and Improvement:**

To analyse user behaviour, trends, and preferences, in order to improve our website, services, and overall user experience.

## **DATA SHARING AND DISCLOSURE**

We may share your personal information with third parties in the following circumstances:

### **3.1. Service Providers:**

We may engage trusted third-party service providers to perform certain functions on our behalf, such as search engine optimisation, data hosting, marketing, and customer support. These service providers have access to your personal information solely for the purpose of performing their designated tasks and are obligated to maintain the confidentiality and security of your information.

### **3.2. Legal Requirements:**

### **3.3. Business Transfers:**

In the event of a merger, acquisition, or other corporate transaction, we may transfer your personal information to the relevant third parties involved in the transaction. We will notify you of any such transfer and provide you with the opportunity to opt-out if your personal information will be used contrary to this Privacy Policy.

### **3.4. Partner Sharing:**

We may share your data with 79th Group, our partner company, to facilitate investment-related activities and communications. 79th Group is obligated to handle your data in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable data protection laws
